#### **AIMS OF THE WORKSHOP:**

- To explore potential areas for collaboration on Health research between Latin American and Caribbean (LAC) countries and Europe (EU)
- To analyze different possibilities for the funding and the governance of the EU-LAC collaboration in Health Research.

In the framework of this EU-LAC Health 2<sup>nd</sup> scenario workshop relevant scientists and representatives of funding agencies will discuss potential areas for EU-LAC collaboration in health research as well as possible funding instruments and governing structures able to support this collaboration.

The analysis of the potential areas for cooperation in health research between EU-LAC regions and the identification of the added value of such collaborations is considered a very important subject within the EU-LAC Health project. For that reason, we have selected six important health research areas for first analysis and discussion during the first day of the workshop. Each research area will be presented by renowned scientists coming from both regions.

On the second day, the main focus will be on the possible governance and funding mechanisms for EU-LAC Health governing Body, taking into consideration the Scenarios 2 and 3 from the 1<sup>st</sup> Scenario Building Workshop held in Buenos Aires.

**EU-LAC Health** (*Defining a Roadmap for Cooperative Health research between the EU and Latin America-Caribbean countries: a Policy Oriented Approach*) is a project funded by the European Commission which has as its main aim to define a roadmap for Cooperative Health Research between the EU and Latin America and Caribbean countries.
