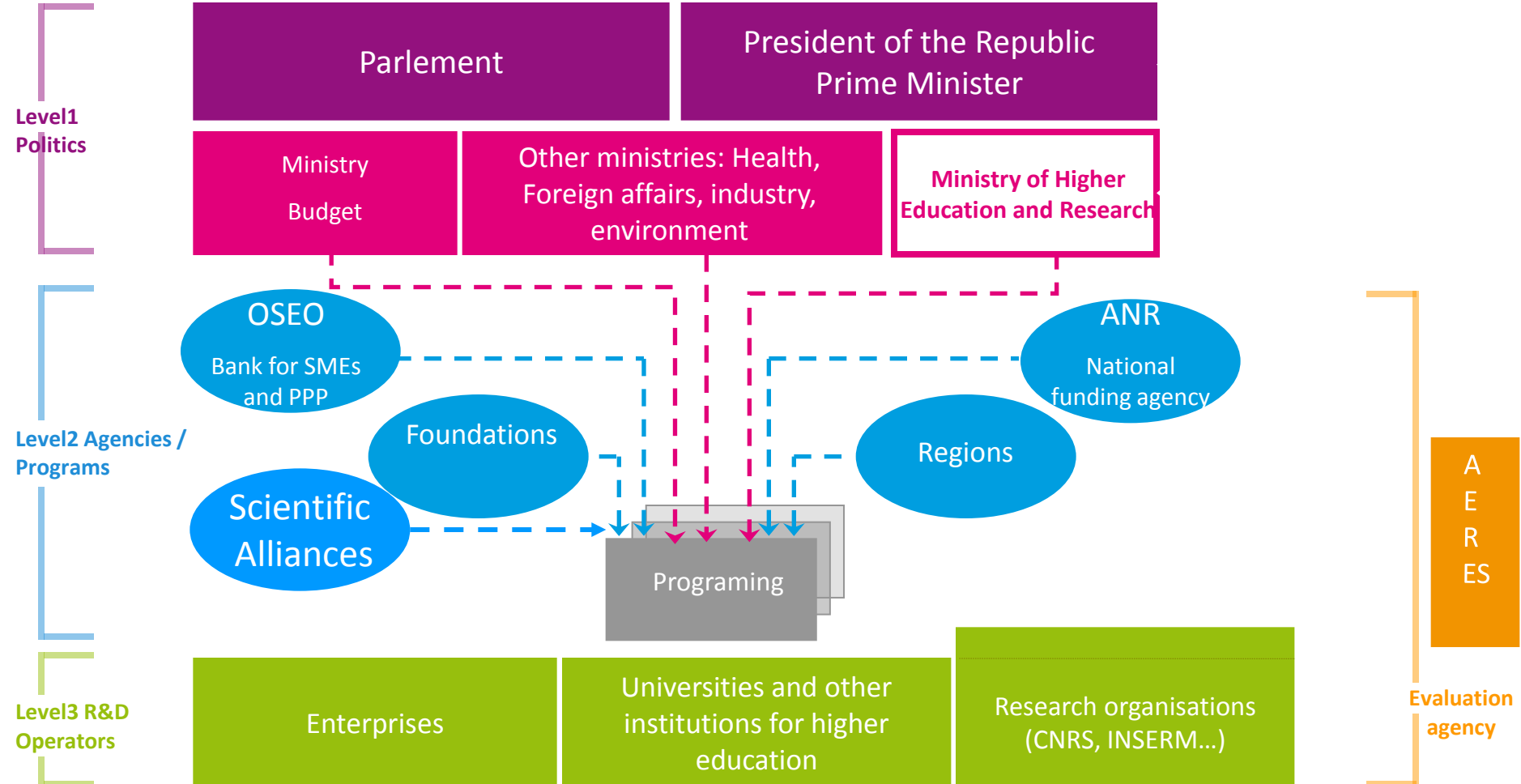
National Strategies for R&I for a better participation in European programs

NSRI: priorities

Challenge 1 : health, well-being, food and biotechnologies

Priorities: emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases, ageing, mental health, chronic diseases, cohorts, modelling, , neurodegenerative diseases, key technologies for a more personalized medicine, biotechnologies and synthetic biology

Challenge 2 : environmental urgency and ecotechnologies

Challenge 3 : information, communication and nanotechnologies

NSRI for international collaboration with China, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Singapore, India, Brazil (in preparation)

EU main tools: SFIC and joint programming

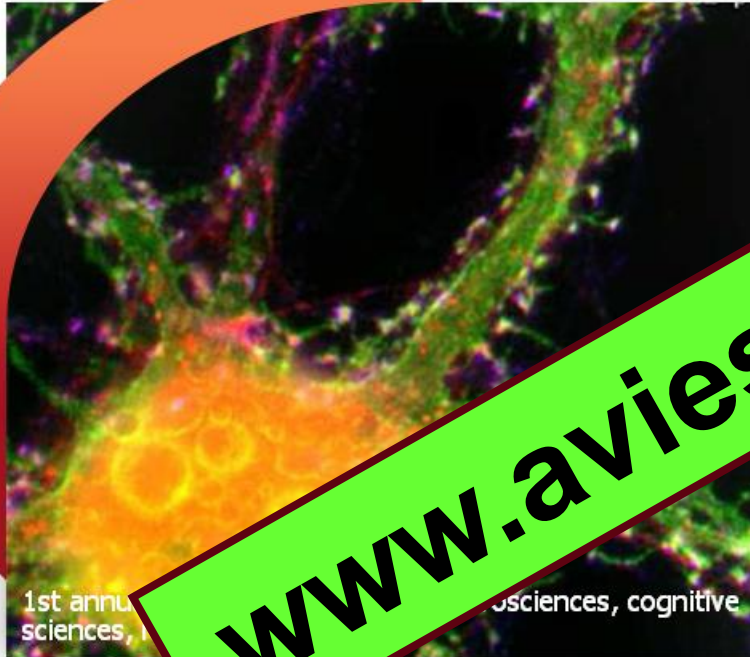
