# EU LAC Health Project



**What is it?** *EU-LAC HEALTH* is a five-year project, financed by the European Commission within the 7<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme.

**What does the Project look for?** EU-LAC Health's aim is the development of a common roadmap that will intensify the bi-regional collaboration between the EU, Latin America and the Caribbean in the area of health research.

**What is the expected outcome?** By October 2016, a joint initiative on health research is expected to be operational.

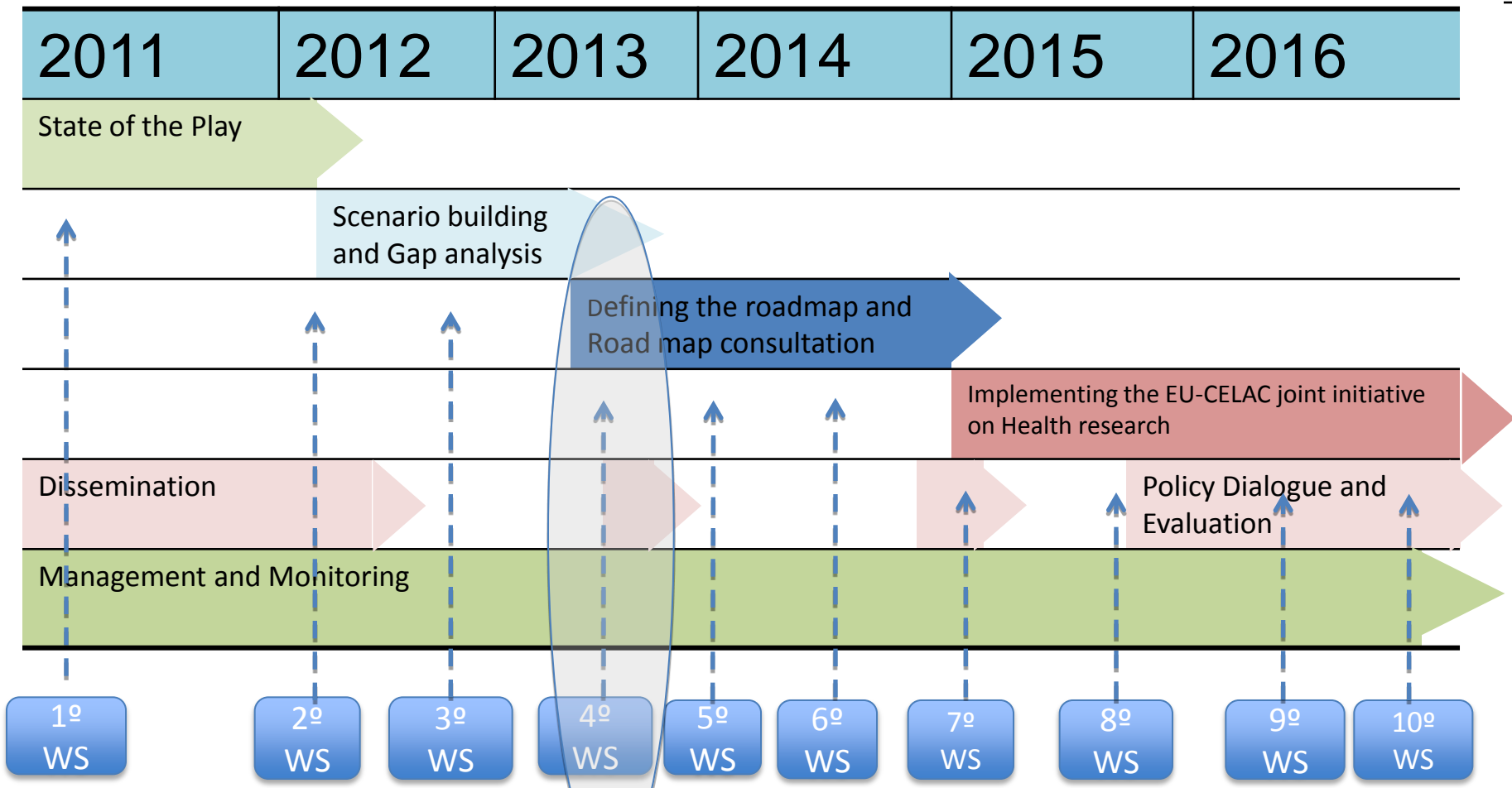

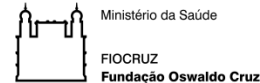
