***What is it?*** *EU-LAC HEALTH* is a five-year project, financed by the European Commission within the 7<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme.

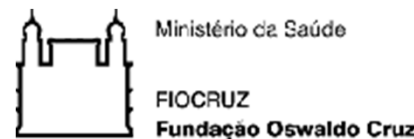

***What is the expected outcome?*** By September 2016, a joint initiative on health research is expected to be operational.

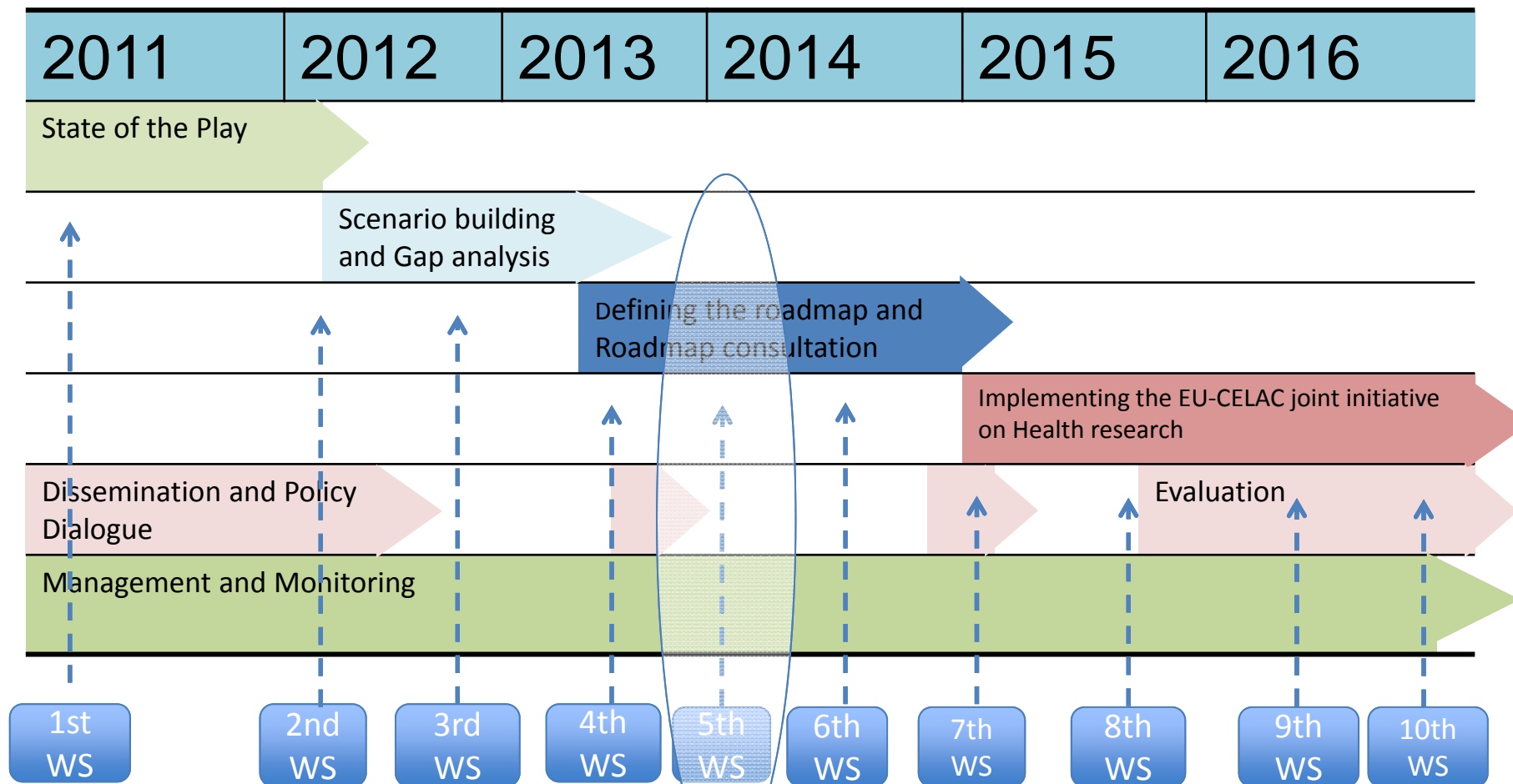

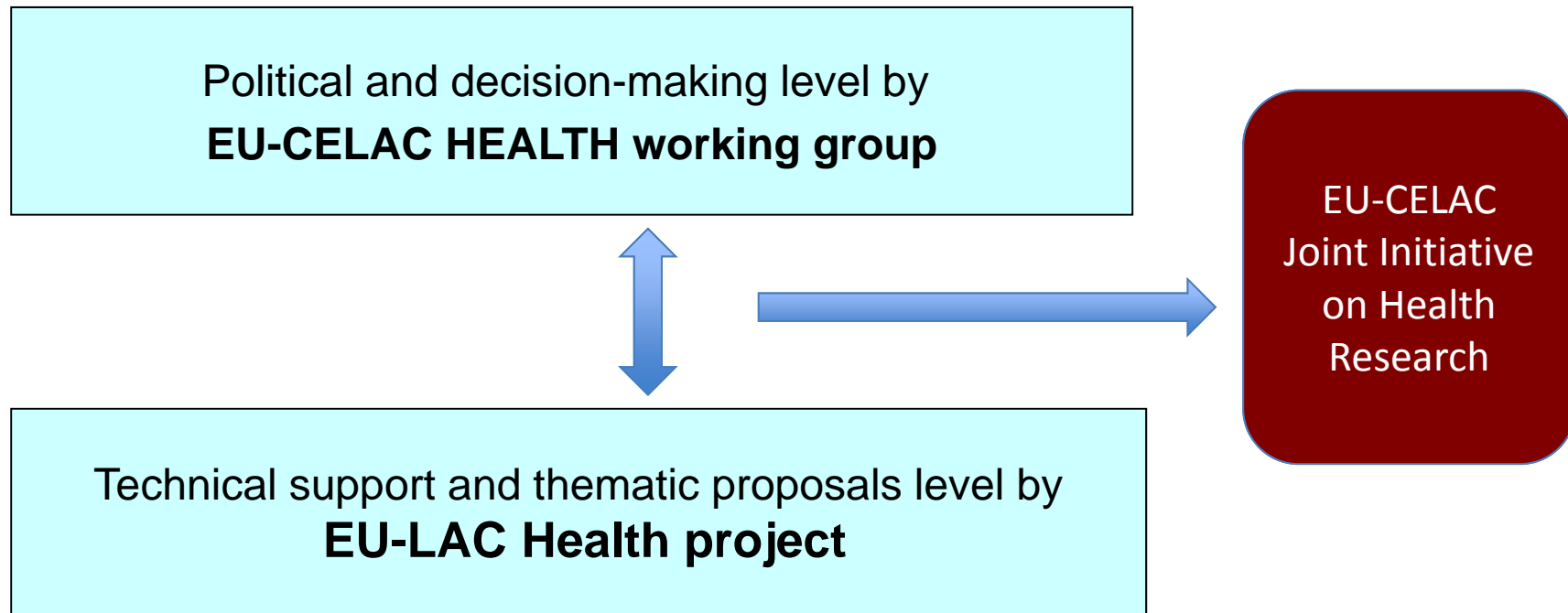

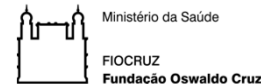
