What is it? *EU-LAC HEALTH* is a five-year project, financed by the European Commission within the 7th Framework Programme.

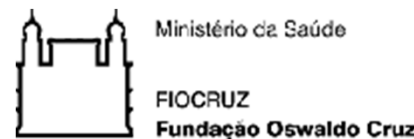

What is the expected outcome? By September 2016, a joint initiative on health research is expected to be operational.

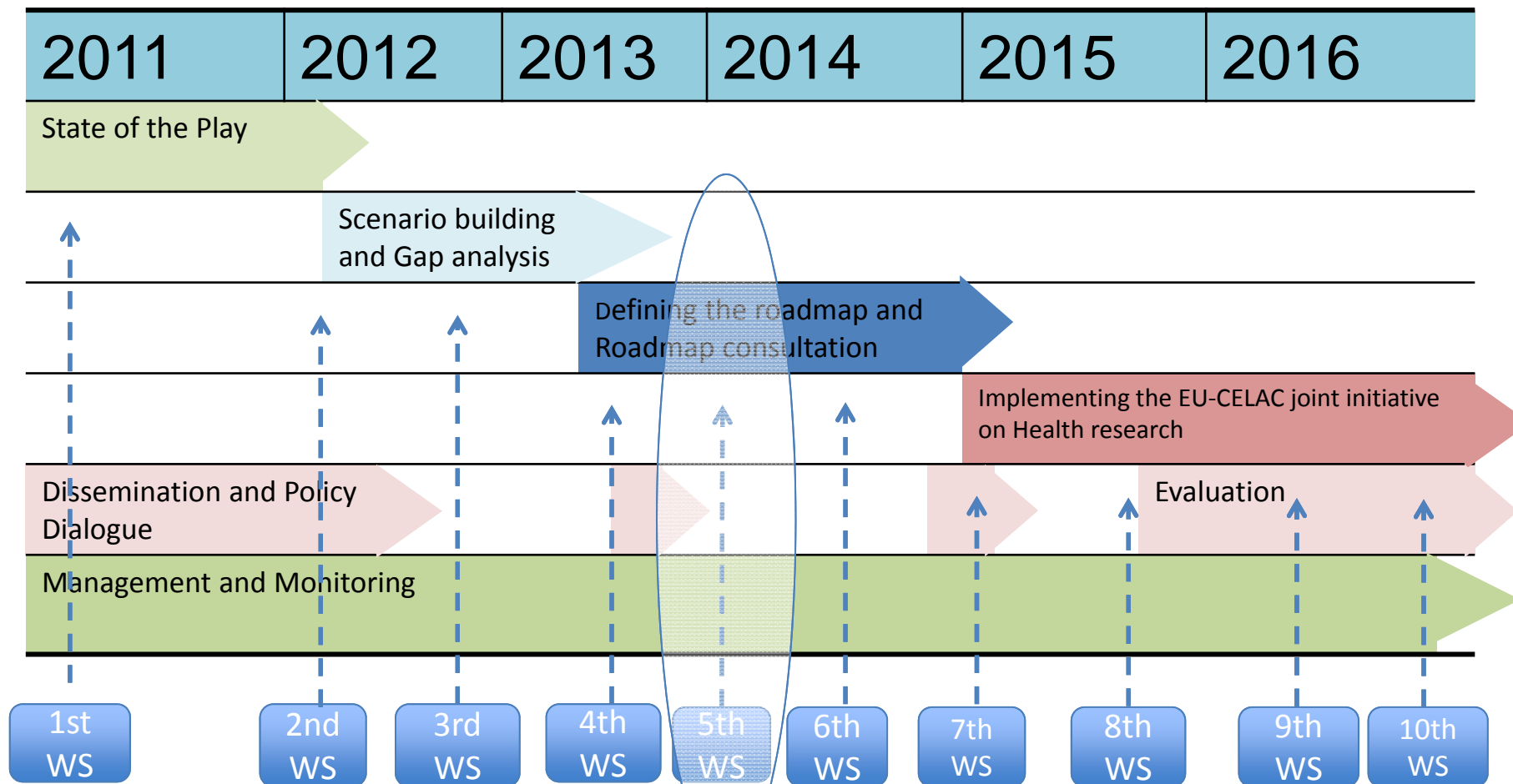

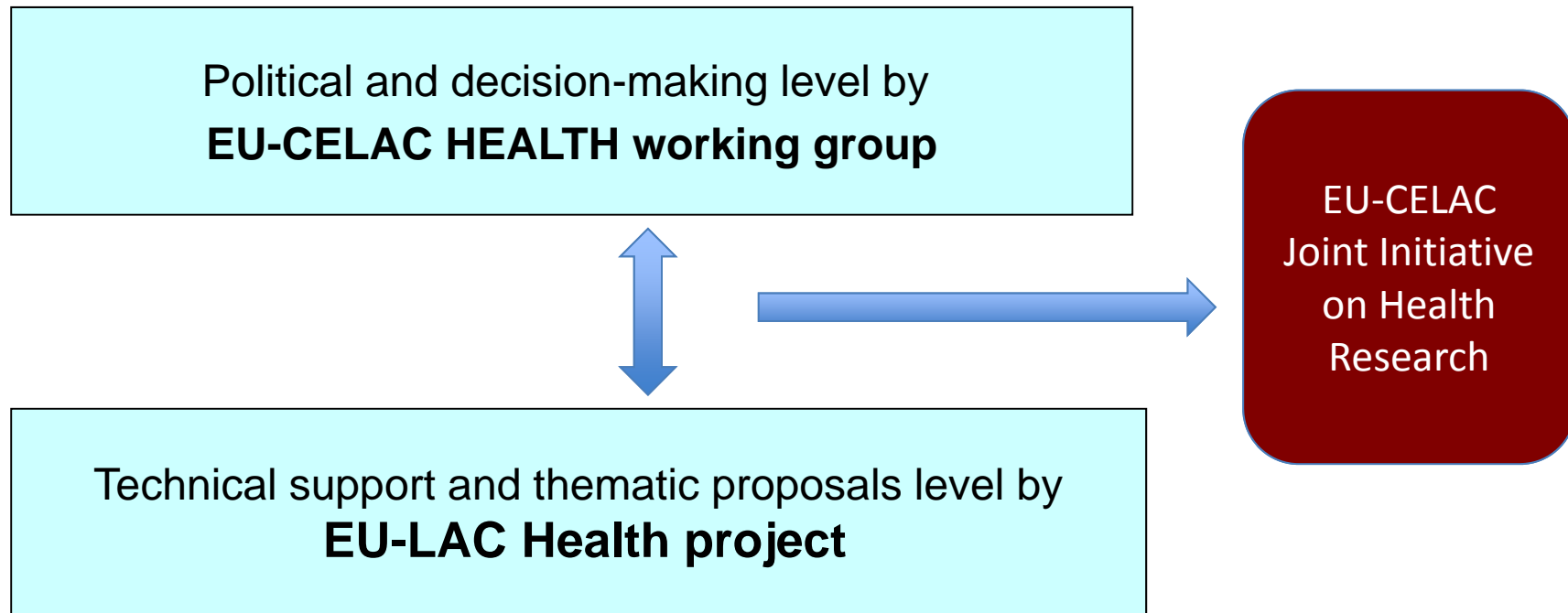

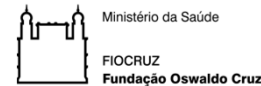
