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EU-LAC Health have as main goals to:



- a) Discuss and explore, with policy-makers, researchers and other stakeholders, how to best coordinate health research policies and funding between EU and LAC.
- b) Define a consensus roadmap for cooperative health research with the final objective of setting up a future sustainable framework for collaboration between the EU and LAC regions in this field.
- c) Disseminate the project results to the main project stakeholders as a means to increase and improve support for EU-LAC cooperation in health research.

Roadmap Consultation and Validation



- An advanced first draft of the roadmap has been elaborated based on the validation and consolidation of the inputs from the workshops and the remote consultancy work.
- In order to assess the validity and feasibility of the first draft of the roadmap, an open consultation exercise will be implemented to discuss the document with identified stakeholders, including policy makers, funding agencies, research programs managers and researchers from the EU and LAC region. The open consultation will be carried out by means of this high-level workshop.
